light vehicles

**Height**  
less than or equal to **2m**  
**and GVWR**  
less than or equal to **3,5t**



All saloon, coupé, convertible or estate cars



Hatchbacks or people carriers



Small vans



Most 4x4



All vehicles mentioned above with a trailer of a height, excluding load and accessories, less than or equal to 2 metres



Make sure you respect the height limits for certain toll payment lanes: These lanes are reserved for class 1 vehicles. Light vehicles that, due to an accessory or load on the roof, are taller than 2 metres must use lanes with no height limit.

# Class 2

intermediate vehicles

**Height**  
less than **3m**  
and more than **2m**  
**and GVWR**  
less than or equal to **3,5t**

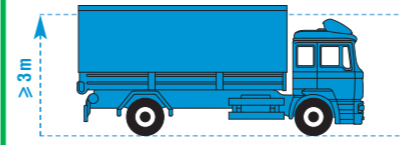

\* Trikes with power >15kW and weight over 550kg are authorised. (Article R421-2 of the French highway code)

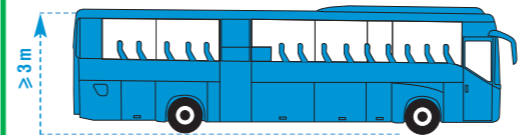

heavy vehicles, coaches and other 2-axle vehicles

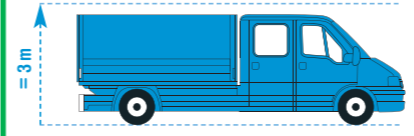

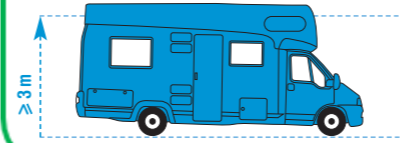
Heavy vehicles with 2 axles

Small heavy vehicles with a GVWR of more than 3,5t

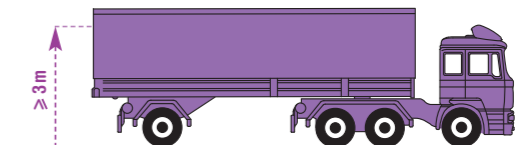


Campervans over 3 metres high

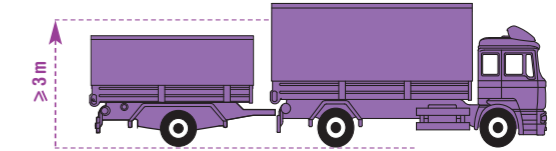

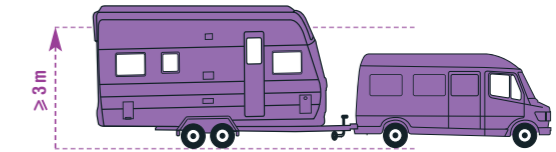

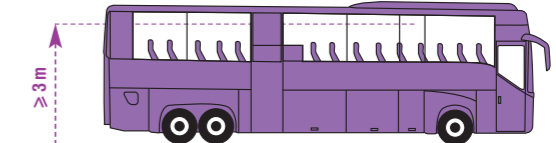
Heavy vehicles with 3 or more axles

## Important: tailored signage



Class 2 vehicles set up to transport people with disabilities are considered class 1

To apply this change of class, use the manned lane. In automatic lanes, call for assistance using the intercom. For vehicles registered in France, only the note "Handicap" for registration documents issued before June 2004 (decree of 22.09.03 from the Ministry of Infrastructure, Transport, Housing, Tourism and the Sea) or the note "handicap" in the J3 section of documents issued after June 2004 is admissible.
